NOTICE OF RACE

(This Notice of Race may be amended from time to time pursuant to rule 89.2b)

The organizing authority will be the Chicago Corinthian Yacht Club in conjunction with the ILCA.

1. RULE

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing and the class rules of the International Laser Class Association.
- 1.2 Appendix P, Special Procedures for rule 42 will apply.
- 1.3 Advertising is restricted per World Sailing regulation 20.
- 1.4 RRS 63.7 shall be replaced by, "If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race (NOR) and the Sailing Instructions (Sis), the Sailing Instructions shall apply." This changes RRS 63.7.
- 1.5 As allowed by RRS88.2, the US Sailing prescriptions to RRS60, 63.2, & 63.4 do not apply.

2. VENUE

- 2.1 The event will be held at the Chicago Corinthian Yacht Club, 601 W Montrose, Chicago, IL 60613.
- 2.2 The racing area will be the open waters of Lake Michigan east of Montrose Harbor.

3. ELIGIBILITY

3.3 Eligibility for entry shall be in accordance with the Lightning, Laser, and Rhodes19 Class Rules, which apply in their entirety. Other than Lasers, Yachts must hold a valid Measurement Certificate. All sails shall have Official Royalty Labels. Mainsail and spinnaker numbers shall be the same. Skipper must be a Life or Active Member of their respective Class Associations.

4. REGISTRATION AND ENTRY

4.1 Competitors shall register in advance by completing the online entry form on

- 4.2 Entry fees received on or before September 10, 2021 will receive a tshirt with entry fee.
- 4.3 Entry Fees Include

Laser Entry Fees include 2 days of racing, dinner on Saturday, one shirt and awards.

Lightning Entry Fees include 2 days of racing, 2 shirts, and awards.

Rhodes Entry Fees include 1 day of racing.

4.4 A minimum of five (5) entries is required to constitute a class.

- 5.2 There will be no warning signal after 1500 on Sunday.
- 5.3 There are seven (7) races scheduled.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available online at www.regattanetwork.com or at the time of check-in.

7. COURSES

Courses are located in the Sailing Instructions.

- 8. SCORING
- 8.1 The scoring system will be the Low Point Scoring in Appendix A as modified below.
- 8.2 One (1) race is required to constitute a championship.

8.3 When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be

the total of her race scores.

8.4 When five (5) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the

total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to first through third place winners in the Lightning, Laser, Radial and

4.7 Divisions, to the top female in the Laser Radial and 4.7 fleets. Rhodes 19 will award a perpetual

trophy.

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

10.1 Competitors participate in this regatta at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to

Race. The organizing authority, the sponsors, the race committee, officers and board

of directors of CCYC, and all those involved in these organizations will not accept any

responsibility for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in

conjunction with or prior to, during or after this regatta.

10.2 All competitors must turn in a signed waiver before racing. Competitors under 18

years of age must have the waiver signed by a parent or guardian.

11. BERTHING

11.1 All boats must be kept in the Montrose Harbor Boat Storage area or on the CCYC Lawn.

11.2 All boats must be removed from the CCYC premises no later than 2100 on September 27,

2021 unless permission has been granted by the regatta chair.
